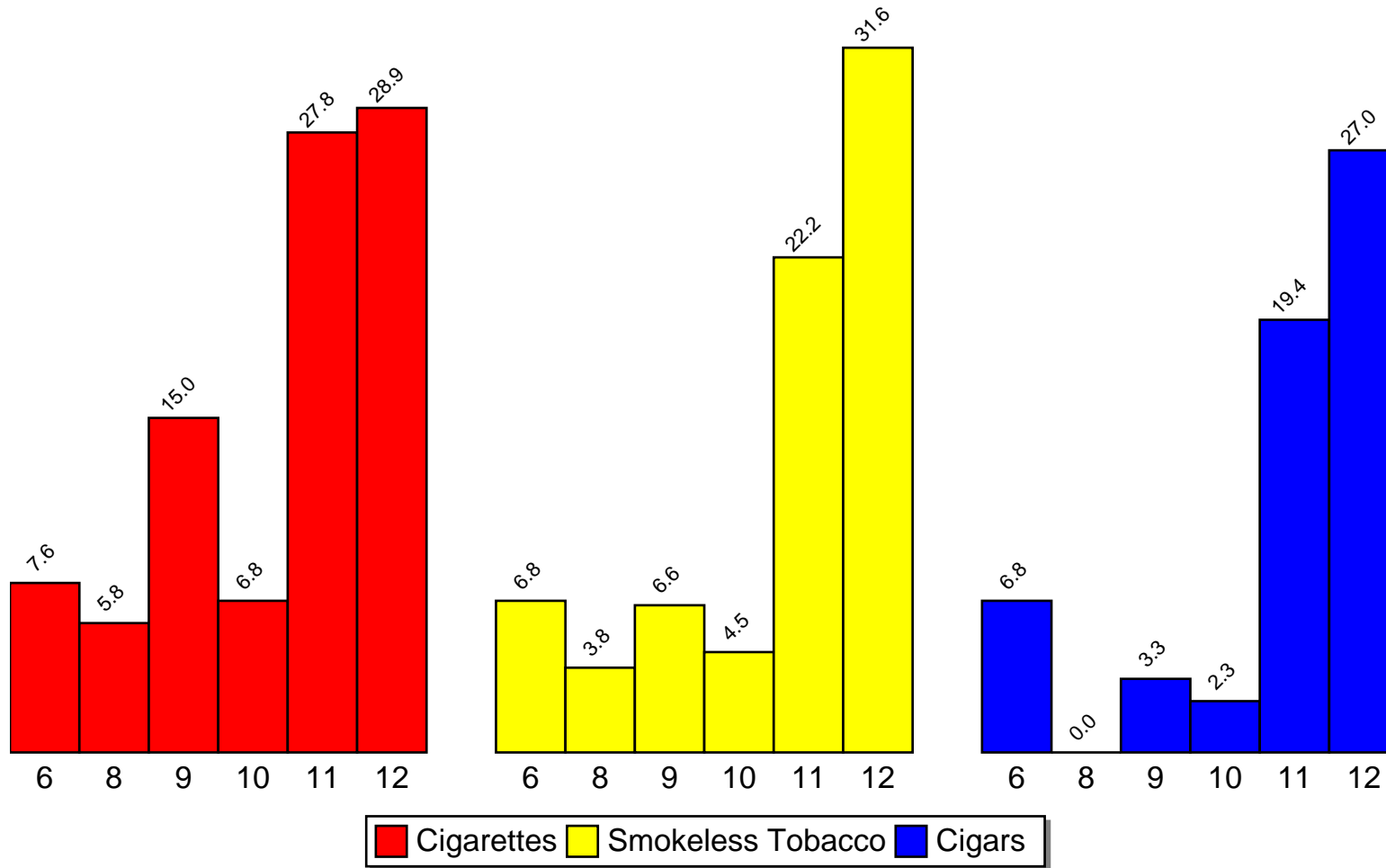


Figure 2.2: During the Past Year My Child Has Used Alcohol

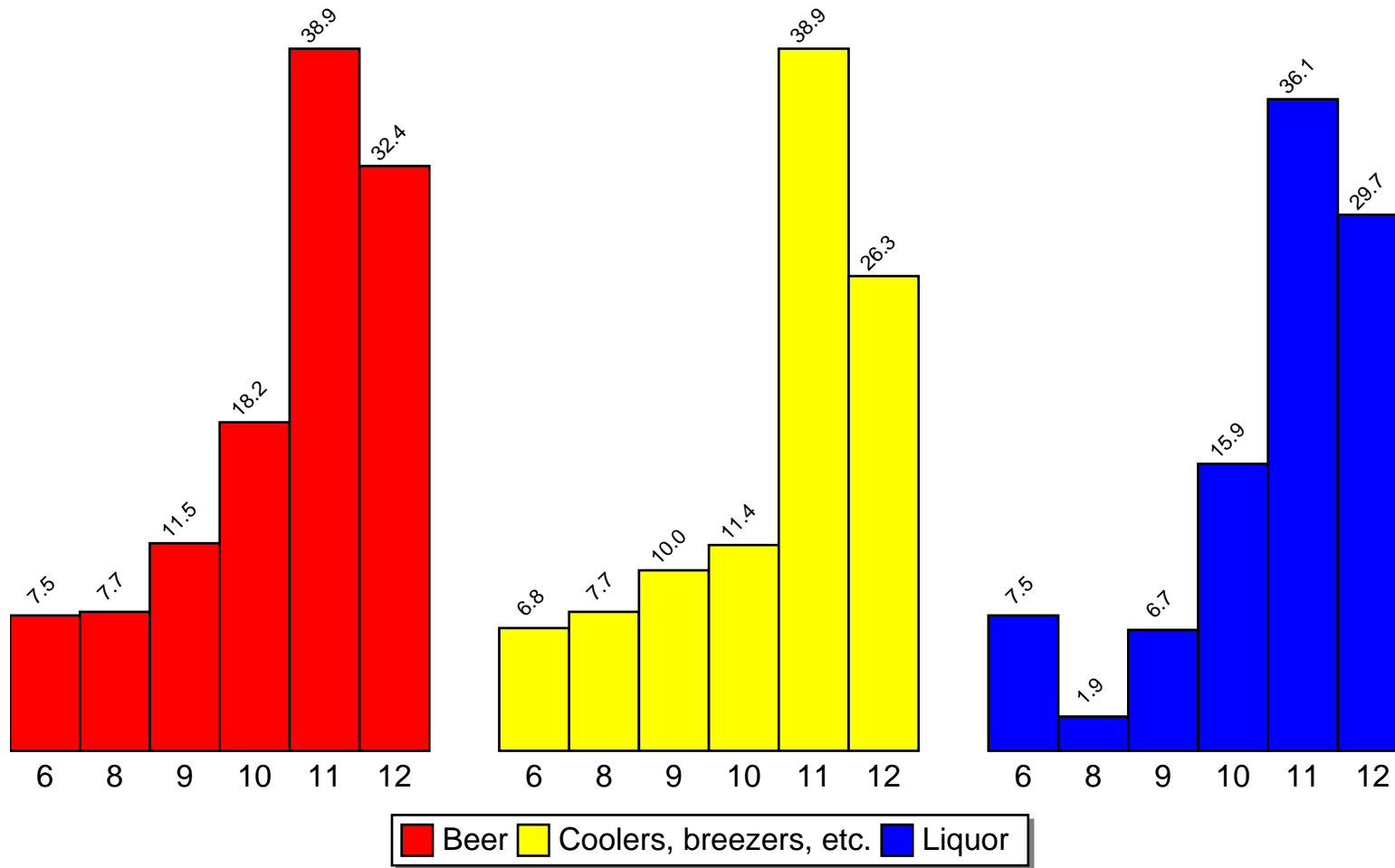
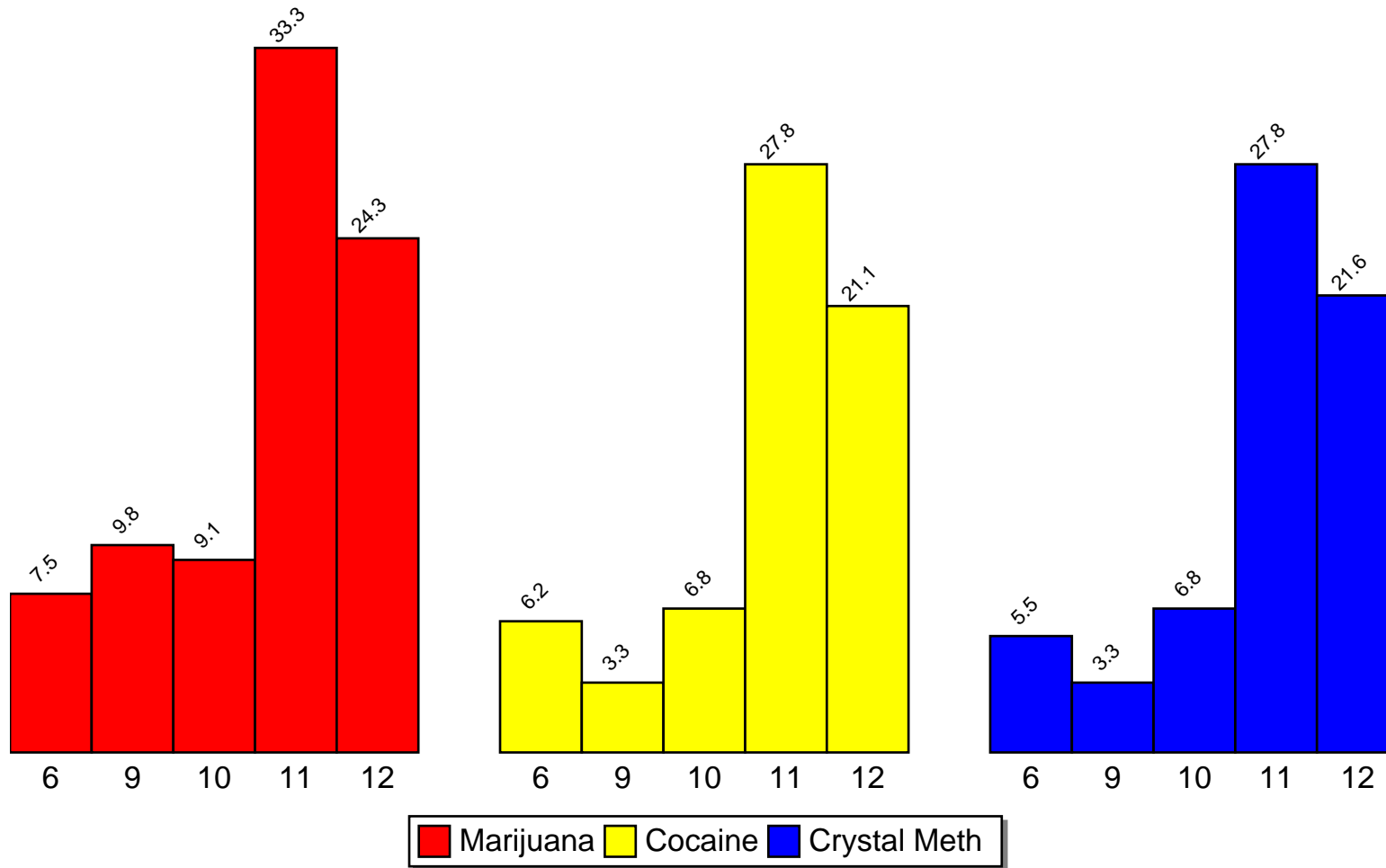


Figure 2.3: During the Past Year My Child Has Used Illicit Drugs






